Nearly 1100 toys were brought for donation to Country Santa (to be given to children in the Upstate South Carolina area), as well as 100 books, and \$160 in cash donations! In every aspect, this year's event set new records. A major round of applause goes to the Autocrat, Maistir Cian mac Cellacháin hUí Dublaich, for his imagination and hard work that resulted in such generosity. - Across the top, list all the awards in the barony and/or the kingdom.
- Then start searching the kingdom OP (<u>http://op.atlantia.sca.org/</u>) for those names, and fill in the blanks. This makes it easy to see at a glance where people stand, and what they might be considered for.

### Seneschals'/Exchequers' Meeting at Unevent 2018

#### Events

- -- They cannot be listed with fees 'TBD' [to be determined]
- -- It is a Society Mandate to post the fees, at least 60 days before the event
  - Otherwise, it becomes a FREE event
- -- Within the 60-day window, you can adjust the fees downward, but Not Up

#### Doomsday / 42 Exchequer Report

-- Must be submitted No Later Than January 31, 2019

- -- If the report is late (i.e. after 1/31), the group IS SUSPENDED!
- -- Use of electronic signatures on the report is preferable (vs. print & scan)
  - -- Contact me (Morwenna) for instructions on doing this

#### New Position in Atlantia: Deputy for Review of Books

- -- Lord Fedor Turovsyn, of Sacred Stone
  - -- He will be contacting all the Exchequers to schedule their reviews
- -- Reviews are required every 2 years or whenever the group Exchequer changes
  - -- Whichever is sooner
- -- Nottinghill Coill's next review will be due at Yule Toy Tourney, December 2019

#### Waivers

-- Due to the Kingdom Waiver Secretary (Baroness Aine ingen Chuimin) 14 days from the close of Troll / Gate

- -- Many of them Are Not being received on time!
- -- Must include the name of the group AND the name of the event
- -- Must submit the original documents, NOT scanned copies
- -- If a person has an expired Blue Card, he / she must sign the Waiver

#### Pay Pal

-- Notify the Pay Pal Deputy (Baroness Gwenllian ferch Gwilim) sooner rather than later

- At least 1 week Before you want to start using Pay Pal

- -- Pay Pal Pre-registration closes 2 weeks before the event
  - -- No Pay Pal pre-registrations can be accepted after that

-- Pay Pal's 'take' = 2.2% + 50 cents per invoice, regardless of how many people are on the invoice

- -- At the gate, the charge is 2.2%, but not a 50 cent invoice fee
- -- Refunds = the amount of the registration LESS the Pay Pal fees
- -- Groups can't use Pay Pal for donations or fundraisers

### Notes from the Seneschals' Meeting at Unevent 2018

#### Pollings

-- We have had issues with labels, and with the format for requesting them

-- Starting to try electronic pollings

-- This works via AEL / ESP (the Atlantian Enterprise Login / Electronic System for Polling)

-- You have to opt in / choose the electronic version for responding, or you'll default to paper polling

-- There currently is a disconnect between the "Proposed Timeline for Baronial Pollings" and the requirements of Kingdom Law section 6.5

-- Master Vlad [Kingdom Seneschal] will fix this

#### Blue Cards [Membership Cards]

-- A Blue Card is the same as having a signed waiver

- -- You Do Not have to sign the back of the card
- -- If a minor has a Blue Card, his parent / guardian Does Not have to sign a minor waiver

#### Quarterly Reports

-- The Kingdom Seneschal is trying to figure out how to capture and keep entered data from one report to the next

-- E.g. change of phone number, etc.

-- Reports are due on July 8 for the 2Q report, due to the July 4 holiday

-- Otherwise, reports are due 5 days after the end of the quarter (1/5, 4/5, and 10/5)

#### Warrants

-- The Kingdom Seneschal prefers issuing electronic versions (notifications) vs. paper ones

-- Seneschal terms are 2 years for the initial term, and 2 years for a following term

-- Limited to a total of 4 consecutive years (i.e. 2 terms)

-- Can return to the same office (same chapter) after a 1 year break **Web Sites (e.g. Facebook)** 

-- If you (personally) have blocked someone, you won't see any of their postings

-- Even if you're both part of the same group

#### Insurance

-- Ask Master Vlad for a copy of the Insurance Policy

-- It can't be posted on-line

-- If you need a specifically-named policy, it must go through Milpitas

-- The charge for naming a specific site on the policy is \$50

-- There is an additional \$175 fee for any such policy that has fewer than 30 days lead time

#### Events

-- If you post updates and/or changes on a Facebook site, Make Sure you update the event website (non-Facebook) as well!

- Announce A&S competitions for upcoming events six months in advance to give people time.
- The KMoAS needs two deputies: a training deputy and one to help with Guilds.
- University sites are needed. Outdoor sites have different requirements than indoor sites. There is a University fund to help cover site fees.
- The A&S Links website has been redesigned and the broken links have been fixed.
- There may be another MoAs meeting at KASF.
- Tempora Atlantia will be at Crown and Twelth night.
- Sign up for the Lyceum at Twelth night to be matched with a mentor at KASF

- Releases need to be obtained from anyone providing a submission to a newsletter. Releases need to be sent to the release deputy. There were various questions about when a release is needed and which release form is the correct one for different scenarios.
- The newsletter should be sent to the King and Queen, Prince and Princess, Kingdom Chronicler, Kingdom Archivist, Kingdom Historian, Baron and Baroness, Baronial Seneschal and Baronial Webminister. Then it should be published to the populace.
- There was some discussion regarding the use of Facebook as an official channel of communication now that there's an official Kingdom Social Media officer. There will be forth coming policies regarding that.
- Some suggestions were offered for how to encourage more participation/submissions from the populace.

#### **Take Away**

- The Quarterly reports will be migrating from a template that is emailed in, to an electronic version that goes directly to the Kingdom and Reginal officers. The report will still need to be emailed to the Baronial Chatelain.
- Baroness Emma, Kingdom Chatelain, requested that we pay attention to not only newcomers, but returning SCAdians as well. It is also important to let current members know they are wanted and appreciated. If there is a member you notice is not attending meetings or fighter practices, contact them and let them know they are missed!
- There was encouragement to share best practices with regards to programs, packets and gifts. What works best for you? What failed? What will you try next?
- Mistress Molly is working with Social Media policy and will be updating us.

#### **Baronial And Canton Future Plans**

- The three of us discussed ways to increase knowledge of the SCA, participation in our demos and encouraging member presence. We agreed that a Monthly Chatelain meeting would be beneficial in sharing ideas and helping each other. Azzah is investigating internet options.
