Cabochon Award Medallions

Are you looking for largesse that is easy to make in great abundance that is also GREATLY needed both on a kingdom and baronial level? Look no further!

These cabochon award medallions are your ticket to largesse nirvana! They are fairly simple to make.



We'll start with the materials you'll need to obtain to start:

☪ Settings:

- ☞ *E6000 glue*

Firstly, you'll need to print out the medallion designs on the photo paper. I recommend copying and pasting the image into a Word document from the Kingdom OP website. Right-click on the image, click 'Size and Position'. If you're using 25mm cabochons and settings, you'll want to change the image height and width to 1 ". If you're using 30mm cabochons and settings, you'll want to change the image and width to 1.2". Copy the newly sized image and paste it into the Word document repeatedly, making sure to keep good space between each image so that they're not hard to cut around later. Once you have the designs the way you want them, print!

Next, take a cabochon and apply a liberal layer of Mod Podge to the flat side. Carefully put the mod podged side of the cabochon down on to a medallion design, pressing down on it and wiggling it around a bit to get rid of any air bubbles. The mod podge will start to dry quickly so center the cabochon on the image as soon as you can. Rinse and repeat. You'll need to let these dry for 24 hours.

A day later, you can use the Exacto knife or scissors to cut the mod podged cabochons apart, carefully trimming around the edge once separated. Now it is time to glue the cabochon into the setting. Open the glue and apply a small amount to the center of the setting. Place the cabochon into the setting and spin it around to spread the glue. Arrange the cabochon so that the top of the design lines up with the top of the setting. Allow to dry for 72 hours for the E6000 glue to fully cure.
