Martial Readiness in a Time of Plague

While it is necessary for us to remain apart during this time, as your Baronial champion, I am writing this missive to the skilled fighters of our beloved Barony in order to exhort you to remain steadfast in your perpetual readiness for conflict. While the sickness has temporarily laid low the enemies of our fair land, it shall hopefully pass in time, and even now the rumblings of wars to come can be heard. Since we cannot train in our normal manner, I am issuing a personal challenge to all our fighters (and prospective fighters) to spend this time to hone our fighting skills, whether it be via practice or research.
