We also just witnessed the Investiture of Our latest Cousins in Hawkwood. Please do not do this. Individuals are recognized by the Crown in consultation with the Order in question. The question puts the burden wrongly on the person to whom the question has been asked. It is not up to them to be recognized, that burden belongs to Their Majesties and the Order in question. Instead ask "What do you think of the Order of {fill in one of several orders, the Golden Dolphins, the Pearl, the Laurel}?" This will elicit a much better response. And if you feel that the person has been overlooked by that Order, that means you should write an award recommendation. The Crown and Order members can't be everywhere and can't see everything, especially now. This is where recommendations are a great help.

Border Skirmish 2020: Virtual SCA Extravaganza is coming up. This event is inspired by The Garden of Earthly Delights, by Hieronymus Bosch. The veil between worlds is thinning and we mortals have come together to celebrate the Blue Moon of October. Notice of Baronial Meeting online Monday Oct 19

There will be a brief Baronial Meeting held during the Baroness' Cyber Tea on Monday evening, October 19. All members of the Barony are encouraged to attend. The meeting part will only last a few minutes and will start at 7:15 PM.

Their Excellencies, the Baronial Exchequer, and I are requesting a minor change to the Financial Policy regarding the makeup of the Financial Committee.

Section 3.1 of the Financial Policy states:

"The Financial Committee shall consist of the Exchequer, the Seneschal, and one other officer."

We would like to change that line to read:

"The Financial Committee shall consist of the Exchequer, the Seneschal, and one other Baronial paid member at-large"

This will give a greater number of people to choose from as the third member of the Baronial Financial Committee, and will lessen the need to change the Financial Committee makeup if an officer steps down from their office. The third member of the Financial Committee is a signatory on the Baronial account, and it can sometimes be difficult to coordinate adding/removing signatories on the account.

I would encourage anyone who has questions or comments on this proposed change to please say so on the Baronial Facebook Page, the Baronial E-list, or in email to myself and/or Their Excellencies prior to the meeting.

During the meeting, a vote will be taken to approve/disapprove the change. Only paid SCA members may vote, but we encourage anyone who has a comment or an opinion to speak up, regardless of membership status.
