# From the Seneschal's Pen...

Well, here we are. December already. The end of 2021. Know what this means? YULF TOY TOURNEY!

We are blessed to be able to have it this year, and many thanks to Lady Meadhbh and her staff for taking on this task, especially with all of the Covid rules that we have in place. This event is one of my favorites, and I'm anxiously looking forward to it. Let's see how many toys we can raise this year for Country Santa!

Some reminders of Covid rules. You MUST pre-register for the event. If you have not pre-registered, you will not be allowed on site. You MUST present proof of vaccination (a photo or scan of your card is fine) or a negative covid test from an authorized medical provider done within 72 hours of the event starting. That means the earliest you can get a negative test is 5pm on Tuesday, December 7. Any test before that is not current enough. Youth under 12 do NOT have to show proof of vaccination or negative covid test, but youth 12 and up do.

Masks MUST be worn by all individuals 3 years old and up inside, regardless of vaccination status. Masks are required outdoors for all children 3-11 and for all unvaccinated persons. Vaccinated people are not required to wear masks outdoors, but it is highly recommended. Any concentrated groups outdoors (such as a court) are required to wear masks. Masks are not required for participants in martial activities. Masks must be worn properly, covering the nose and mouth.

Folks, if you have not pre-registered for an event, or cannot/will not provide proof of vaccination or negative covid test, you WILL be turned away. Don't make us do that. Regardless of your personal beliefs on Covid and vaccinations, these are the rules set down by Society and Kingdom, and they are non-negotiable.

Ok, Brute Squad Cian rant out of the way. On to better things!

There will be a morning and an afternoon court at Yule Toy Tourney. There will also be a Baronial Populace Meeting at 3pm, 1 hour before court. I don't anticipate it lasting longer than 30 minutes, hopefully even less. If anyone has something they wish brought up or addressed, please let me know as soon as possible.

Baronial Birthday is coming up in March! It's been spiked and is on the calendar. Lady Giulia Stanizi will be autocratting her first event here in Nottinghill Coill. Be on the lookout for more information on the event and activities as time grows closer. It should be a fun one!

With it being December, the holiday season is upon us. This can be a time of great joy, or a time of great sorrow. If you are having troubles this season, of any kind, please reach out for help. If the idea of picking up hot metal with a bare hand is already bringing to mind the time you touched a hot stove, then you understand why tongs are an essential part of a blacksmith shop. In a smithy, unless there is standing water on the metal, treat it as though it is hot. This is because metal can reach temperatures of up to 800 degrees before "glowing", and temps that high will produce 2<sup>nd</sup> degree burns in as little as one second.

Now that we have the warning out of the way, let's get talk tongs. Tongs have been in use since before written records were kept on metallurgy. Whether wooden, bamboo, or metal, tongs add a layer of protection to a dangerous craft. They can also be used to manipulate the material being forged. Tongs come in a variety of lengths, shapes, and sizes depending on their intended use. Some tongs can be used in several ways, some are for only one use, but all are important to a smith.

In early periods, tongs had a simple shape, as seen in the image at the top. They were used to move, hold, and manipulate the metal, but were of limited use. The flat jaw tongs in the second image hold a range of flat or rectangular material, but are limited in the same way that period tongs are limited. Anything round, or thicker than a certain amount, and the metal will move with every strike.

The scrolling tongs, are useful for making, well, scrolls at the end of a piece of steel. They are handy when speed is needed due to rapid cooling of the metal, otherwise, a smith will use his hammer and anvil to make the scrolls needed.

The pick-up tongs are useful for when a piece of metal is accidentally dropped on the ground/floor. Notice I said "when", because it IS going to happen, and will happen throughout a blacksmith's career. The first lesson a smith learns by trial and error is to NEVER try to catch a piece of steel while it is falling.

This hurts! A lot. Don't do it. Let it fall and pick it up off of the floor. WITH TONGS!

The pick-up tongs are also handy for holding punches and other struck tools, as long as the tongs, or the tool, is made to work with one another.

The nippers are used for trimming small pieces of steel, such as horseshoe nails. There is evidence of nippers from the Middle Ages, but at the moment, I've not found them in ancient times.

Tongs, along the ages, began to become specialized. This occurred as smiths became specialized. A farrier's needs were different from an armorer, just as the tinsmith's needs were different than that of a toolmaker. You can see this not only in period tongs, but also in modern tongs as well.

Tongs will forever be in a Blacksmith's toolchest, and indispensable in the daily creations in their shop. Tongs are used to make the iron out of ore, to forge the iron into usable billets, to create beautiful works that have lasted centuries, and will continue to last for centuries more.

Our next article will concern itself with anvils, and as always...
