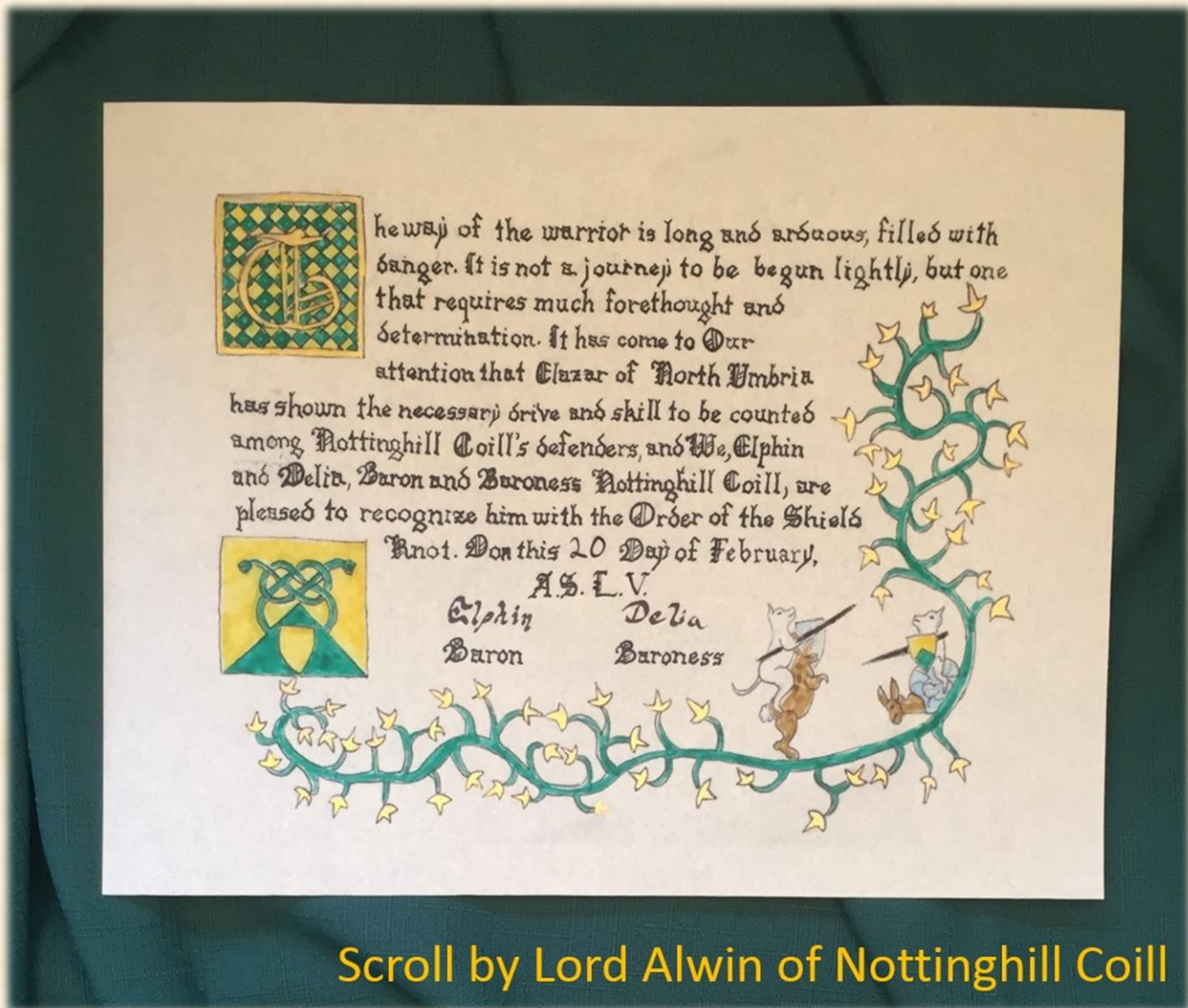
As usual, Nottingham Coill showed what we are made of. Congratulations to everyone who received recognition in February for the great work that you do. We are all proud of you!

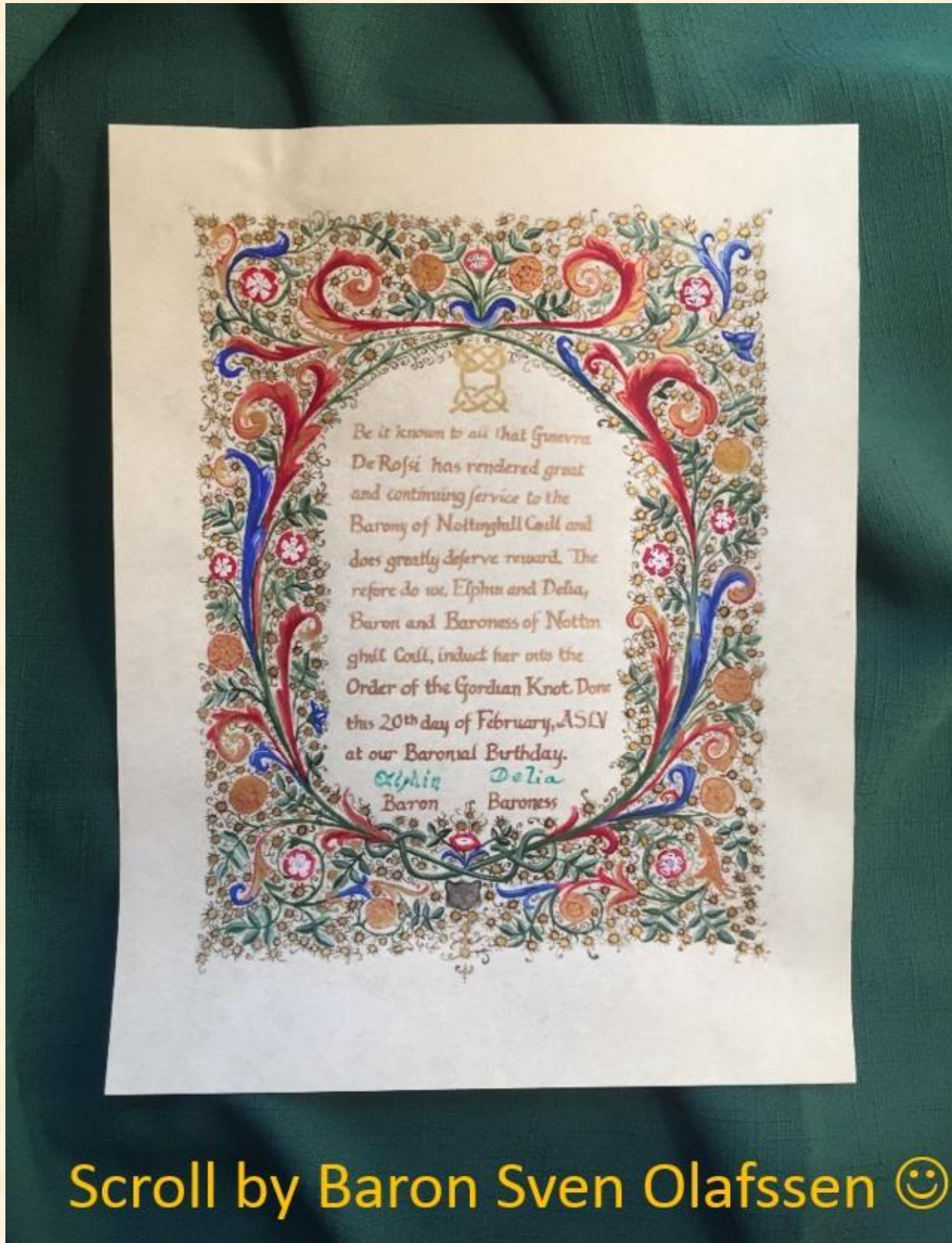

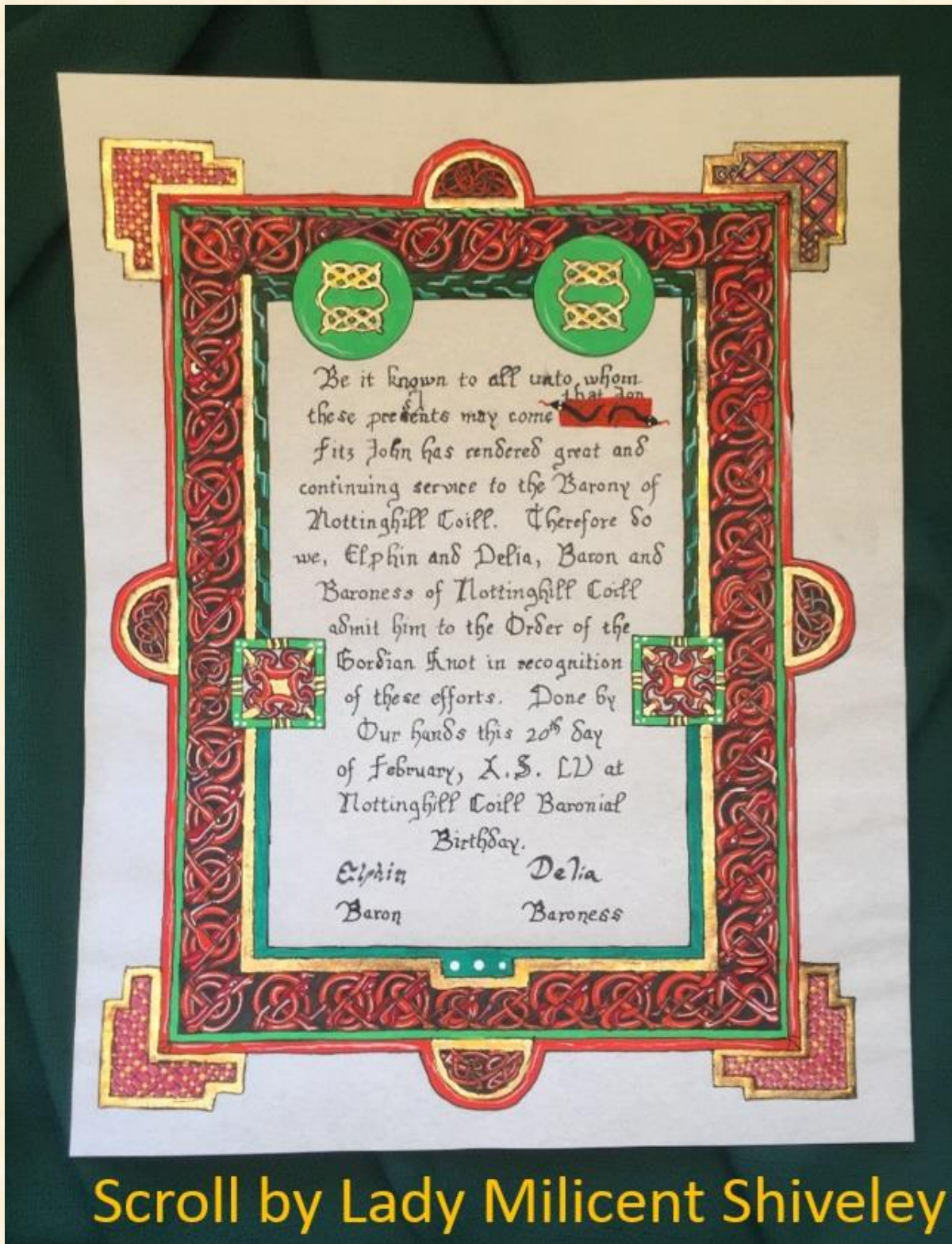

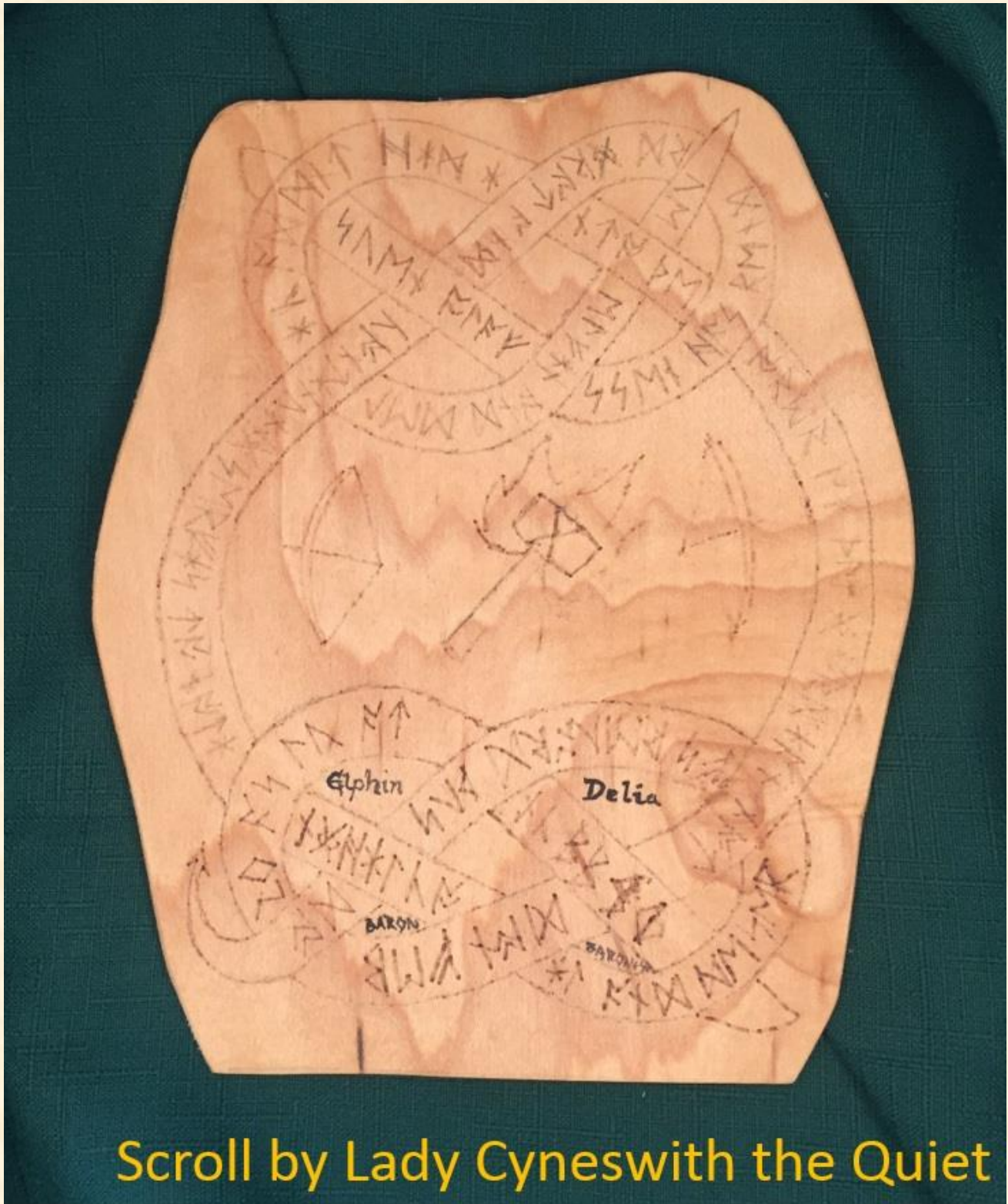

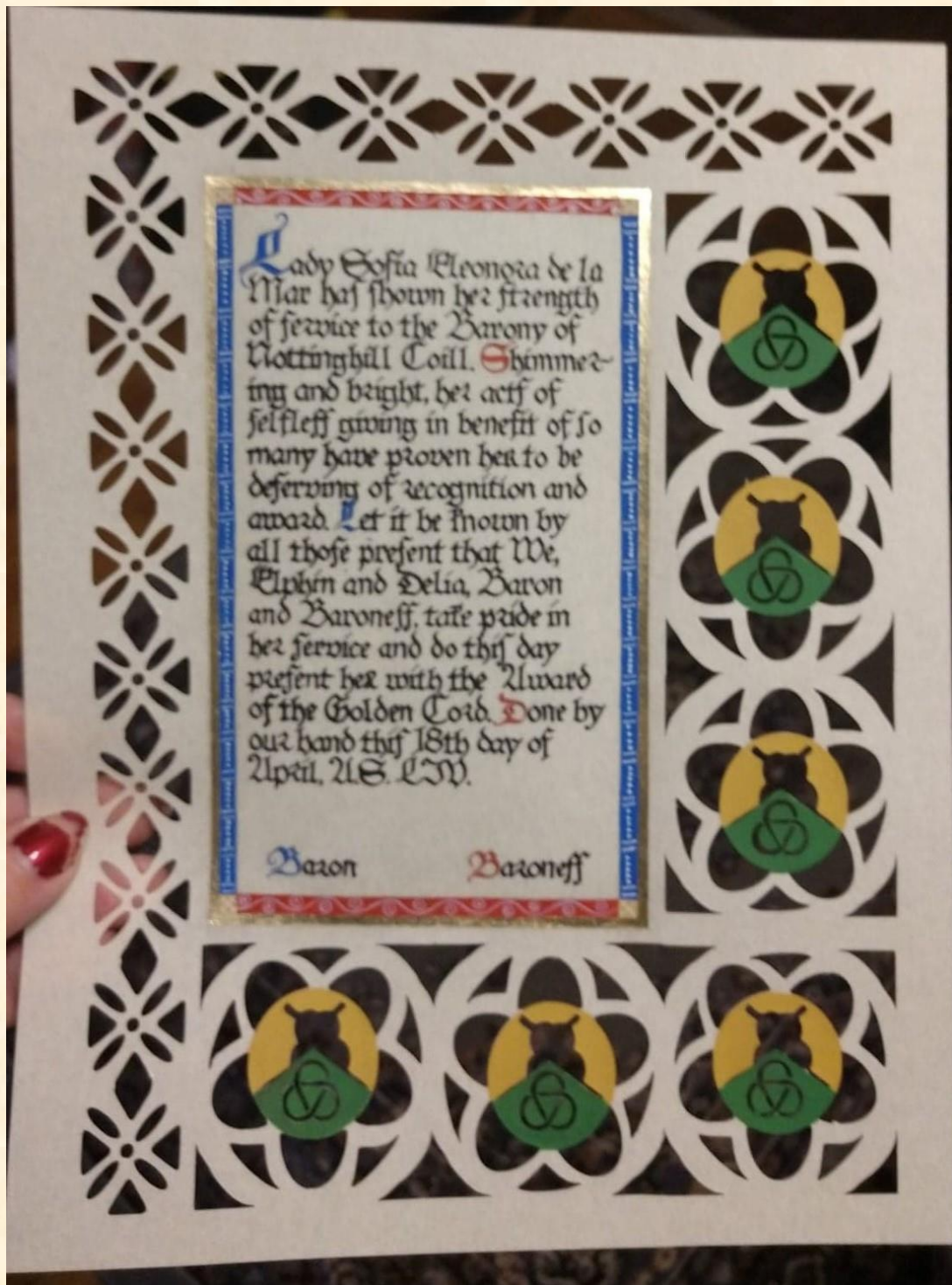

This Month in Plague History: March 1348

In March of 1348, the Black Death hit Florence, which may have been the most densely populated city in Europe at the time. Bocaccio would famously record the effect of the plague on Florence with his Decameron. His claims that over 100,000 people died in Florence by June alone are an exaggeration typical of historians of the time. It was more like 50,000. Still, as the plague begins to ravage central Italy, the death toll is mounting. On the 20th of March, Andrea Dandolo, the Doge of Venice convened a council to discuss opening new burial plots more remote from the city center to accommodate the increase in diseased corpses. Large funeral barges will carry bodies to the new cemeteries, but the newly dead will soon fill them.
