A Poem in Old Norse Edda style

Norse poetry of the middle ages was typically organized in style called Drottkvaett. Not all poems from the Norse era followed this format, but it appears to be the typical format of Norse poetry. Drottkvaett was a highly alliterative style of poetry with stresses of 3 or more syllables per line. This style had stanzas of 8 lines written in blocks two lines wide and four lines high, with a larger space between lines one and two, three and four, etc. The layout/stanza break looked something like this:

This is line one
Line three goes here
Line five is next
Last row starts with line seven

And this is line two
And Line four follows thus
And line six is over here
And ends with line eight.

While the first two stanzas of the poem do follow the Drottkvaett format, I took liberties with the last stanza making it ten lines. This particular piece was inspired by Baroness Nezhka's "The first rule of bardic is Don't apologize!" which she stated at Nottinghill Coill's Baronial Birthday earlier this year.

After all, I still sort of am Nottinghill Coill's bard and I have a duty to the crown.

This Month in Plague History: April 1348 & 1349

April 1348:

In Southern France, the plague hits the town of Avignon, which has been the residence of the Popes and their associated courts since the early 1300s. Pope Clement VI orders prayer processions in the hope of sparing the city, but they are unsuccessful. In the words of Louis Heyligen, a musician in the employ of Cardinal Giovanni Colonna, "To be brief, at least half the people in Avignon died; for there are now within the walls of the city more than 7000 houses where no one lives, because everyone in them has died, and in the suburbs, one might imagine that there is not one survivor." After the dead fill the cemeteries in the city, Pope Clement consecrates the Rhone River as a burial ground, and a stream of corpses begins to flow down the river to the Mediterranean. Historians believe that the plague also arrives in Iberia during April.

April 1349:

As the plague spreads throughout Europe, particularly in Germany, the Jewish residents of many towns endure most of the blame due to a lack of scientific understanding of the disease's origins. Despite a Papal Bull absolving the Jews of responsibility during the previous Fall, popular riots target many Jewish communities. On April 30th, the Jewish community of Radolfzell, Germany is exterminated by the town's Christian residents. This follows similar pograms in Speyer, Strasbourg, Zurich, Worms, and Erfurt earlier that spring.
