We Have Heirs!

This past weekend, May 1, the start of the 56th year of the Society, Their Majesties Anton and Luned did hold a Crown Tournament at Elchenburg Castle. His Highness Prince Eckehard was successful in His quest, and He and Princess Jane will be the next monarchs of Atlantia. Coronation is planned for the last weekend in June at Elchenburg. Duchess Simone, the Kingdom Seneschal, is carefully monitoring Covid data to determine how many people might be able to attend.

The current plan is that TRH will have 2 months as Prince and Princess, then They will step up as King and Queen. There will be no Coronation in October, but there will be a Crown Tourney in November, as is traditional. From that point on, the Kingdom will be back on its regular schedule.

I was fortunate enough to be able to attend Crown Tourney, and have written up my experience and feelings about it in a separate missive for the Quill.

As you all know, Pennsic has been postponed once again. Cooper's Lake Campground is going ahead with a similar event, not affiliated with the SCA, in an effort to gain some income and keep the campground open. Anyone is welcome to attend if you wish, and if you prefer not to attend but want to help Cooper's Lake stay open, they do have a link on their site where people can make donations.

Their Excellencies have informed me that They wish to extend their time as Baronage for another 2 years. I am beginning the process of a Polling of Confidence that will go out in late summer to all registered members of the Barony. You must be a paid member of the SCA to receive and participate in the polling.

This past year has been rough on everyone. It's been very stressful, and we've been without our usual outlet for relaxing and relieving stress because of

Covid. We are starting to see some light at the end of the tunnel, and this past weekend showed that it is possible to have small events safely. But we still have a ways to go.

I hope all of you are doing well. As usual, if you need anything or anyone to talk to, please reach out to Their Excellencies, myself, or anyone else you feel comfortable talking with. Together, we will get through this and return to our fun and fellowship.

Spring Crown Tournament 2021 - What It Was Like

This past weekend, on May 1, Their Majesties held Their Crown Tournament to determine Their Heirs. It was a small even held at Elchenburg Castle, and only those fighting, being fought for, or working staff were allowed to attend.

I was fortunate to be asked by Triton to be Lead Herald for the event, as he was unable to make it. The decision as an easy one, and there was no hesitation whatsoever in accepting.

I got up early Saturday morning and drove to the site. I had decided to day trip for several reasons, one of which was the day before the event was my son's 20th birthday, and I didn't want to miss it. It was a nice but long drive; traffic wasn't too bad fortunately. As I exited I-77 and got closer to the site, I could feel my heart racing a bit and the anticipation building. I reached Elchenburg and turned in from Center Road. There were only 2 pavilions visible, but that was enough to actually bring tears to my eyes for a moment. It has been 2.5 years since I'd been to Elchenburg (I had to miss WoW 2019 due to surgery), and over a year since my last SCA event.

I pulled in, stopped at Troll and filled out paperwork, showed my blue card, and was instructed where to park after I'd dropped my stuff off. I set up under the MoL tent and had the chance to walk around and visit with friends and get plenty of hugs. The combatants/consorts had areas marked off with spray paint on the grass, and were under large umbrellas as opposed to pavilions or day shades, but they were effective.

I met with the IT staff who were setting up for livestreaming and recording the event for those unable to be there in person. I was highly impressed by the 2 ladies in charge, they had an impressive setup and the knowledge to go with it. They knew what they were doing, and were patient in explaining it to all those who were curious.

The tournament started, with a few minor hiccups as everyone was a bit rusty. It progressed quickly, and before we knew it, we were at the finals. Despite the rust, there

were some great fights, and every fight was clean and honorable. There was laughter and fun in the air as people beat each other with sticks.

At one point, Baroness Ingegerd Kastanrazi was paired against her husband Lord Knutr Vakrsson. The comment was made that it would be a Domestic Dispute, and when Lord Knutr was victorious, I made the comment that he would be sleeping on the couch that night. That evening, Baroness Ingegerd posted a picture on my FB wall of him asleep on the couch!

Royal Court was held after the fighting was done, and it really felt good to be able to herald court again. I've really missed that aspect of the SCA. I was also a little out of practice for heralding, as my throat was sore afterwards, but I recovered quickly.

All too soon, it was time to pack down and leave. We had attendees from pretty much all Baronies in attendance and from all parts of the Kingdom. It was really great to see everyone again after all this time.

I've missed my SCA. I've missed my friends. Crown Tourney was a good way to ease back into it and at least see some of them again. I think the livestream/recording of the tourney was good for those unable to be there in person, because you still got a good look at the activities that were going on. Kudos to the IT team for how well they did.

This event did much good for my heart and my soul. Hopefully, this is the start of better times to come, when we can have small, local events at least to recharge our SCA batteries.

An Olden Shovel Poem Entry

In poetry, as with many other things in the SCA, people sometimes devise interesting way of manifesting that word "Creative" in our name. At The 14th Annual Duke Gyrth Oldcastle Memorial Poetry Smackdown, held at this Spring's KASF, an interesting challenge was laid before the entrants, called An Olden Shovel*. For this challenge, we were asked to write a poem in which the ending word of each verse should be a word taken from a line or lines from a poem written in the SCA period. This challenge took its inspiration from the modern verse form, The Golden Shovel, invented by Terrence Hayes to honor Gwendolyn Brooks. For more information on the modern form, please check out this article from the Poetry Foundation. It is also spiritually similar to the period practice of the cento, which borrows a line or lines from another poem for the composition of a new poem.

For this challenge, I chose as my 'source' line of verse, the final line of Sonnet 88, by William Shakespeare:

Such is my love, to thee I so belong,

That for thy right, myself will bear all wrong.

Using these words as the ending words of my lines, I composed the following:

A Fool's Love

My sorrow is such

A burden that is

Upon my heart, my

Unrequited love

How then came I to

Pine away for thee?

What vain hope that I

Might win your heart, so

Then to thee belong?

But fool is he that

Self does forfeit for

Desp'rate hope of thy

Favor without right

Now none but myself
My grief and shame will
Within my heart bear.
For love brings low all
When that love is wrong

Although it was not part of the challenge, I set out to find a period poetic form to use, based on the number of lines that I would have. With the help of the great sage Google, I found an ancient Greek lyrical form called Anacreontic Verse. It wasn't a perfect match, as poems in that form were usually 20-30 lines, and mine would only be 18, but I decided to try it anyway, with the result above.

This Month in Plague History: May 1347

May 1347

While most contemporary histories of the Black Death tend to focus on its devastating effects on medieval Western Europe, it was in May 1347 when ships from the Genoese colony of Caffa in the Crimean Peninsula arrived in the Byzantine capital of Constantinople. The Genoese in Caffa were the first Europeans recorded as dying of the plague, when, during a siege by the Mongol Golden Horde the previous year, the Mongols catapulted infected bodies over the city walls. However, now they will spread it to the remnants of the Byzantine Empire.

The Byzantines themselves are tenuously holding on the heartland of their once vast empire. During the previous century, they fought the Fourth Crusade and its successor states to win back their capital. They have also just finished an internal civil war over succession to the throne. By 1349, the plague will kill an estimated half of the residents of Constantinople. Coming on the heels of these struggles, the Empire will never quite recover. In the Balkans, the Byzantines lose substantial amounts of land to the Serbians, and in Asia Minor, a new enemy, the Ottoman Turks is appearing. While it will be another century before the Byzantine (or Eastern Roman) Empire officially falls, it is through as a major power in the Eastern Mediterranean.
