Instructions for Baronial Polling of Confidence

Hey, everyone! The polling time is here. The polling will start Sunday August 8 and run through Sunday August 22. It will be an online polling through the Atlantia AEL system. So, how do you do the polling? Glad you asked!

1) Make sure your membership is up to date and active. If you aren't an SCA member, then you cannot participate. If you need to renew your membership, get it done NOW! You may have to wait until the 10th or so for the renewal information to make it down to the Kingdom so you can be verified as a member.

2) If you don't have an AEL account, go create one. This is the same system for responding to Order pollings, University Registration, MOL, Marshallate, etc.

3) Once you have an AEL logon, log on to your account and look on the left side of the window. Click on the link for "Switch to Baronial Pollings". If you see a yellow/red notice that your account is not linked to your membership, or that your membership has expired, then fille out the form that will be sent to the ESP Administrator who will then link your account and verify your membership. Get this done ASAP.

4) Once the polling opens, you can log in and choose 'YES' that you believe Their Excellencies should serve another 2 year term, or 'NO' if you don't think they should. There is a spot for comments if you wish to leave some.

5) The results will be sent to Their Majesties ONLY. Their Excellencies will not see them, I will not see them, the Kingdom Seneschal will not see them. Only the King and Queen will have access to the results.

6) Please help spread the word. If there is anyone that cannot access the AEL for some reason and thus can't vote electronically, let me know ASAP. I can generate and send out postcards that will give temporary access to the AEL system. But I need to know as soon as possible so they can be sent out and received in a reasonable amount of time.

This Month in Plague History: May 1347

While most histories of the Black Death tend to focus on its devastating effects on late medieval Western Europe, it was in May 1347 when ships from the Genoese trading colony of Caffa in the Crimean Peninsula arrived in the Byzantine capital of Constantinople. The Genoese in Caffa were the first Europeans recorded as dying of the plague, when, during a siege by the Mongol Golden Horde the previous year, the Mongols catapulted infected bodies over the city walls. However, now they will spread it to the remnants of the Byzantine Empire.

The Byzantines themselves are tenuously holding on the heartland of their once vast empire. During the previous century, they fought the Fourth Crusaders and their successor states to win back Constantinople. They have also just finished an internal civil war over succession to the throne. By 1349, the plague will kill an estimated half of the residents of the capital city. Coming on the heels of these struggles, the Empire will never quite recover. In the Balkans, the Byzantines lose substantial amounts of land to the Serbians, and in Asia Minor, a new enemy, the Ottoman Turks, is appearing. While it will be another century before the Byzantine (or Eastern Roman) Empire officially falls, it is through as a major power in the Eastern Mediterranean.

In Support of a Long Term &/or Large-Scale A&S Project

Many A&S Competitions and Challenges are both small scale and short term simply by necessity. A&S competitions/challenges often are designed for a single item, or a dozen of the exact same item, with only a month or so to These small-scale competitions are generally a result of event produce it. schedules and it's typical of A&S at many events. The most common examples in our kingdom are Bakers Dozen Largess Derby's (where the artisan produces 13 of a small item, 12 of which are given to Royals or seated Baronage to be given out as largess) and Something in Event Theme/Culture. I happen to love these short-term A&S challenges. They're great skill builders, especially Largess Derby's. The Repetition over short term of one or two new skills to produce 12 same/similar small pieces is a great way to get better at anything. All that said, now is a great time to tackle a Long Term and Large-Scale challenge; something that takes several months and produces a large complex item, or multiple items that make up a whole, requiring a multitude of skills. There are many reasons for taking up this kind of challenge right now.

First there are a lot of larger scale and longer-term A&S challenges happening currently with plenty of time to join them. There are, of course the yearly competitions which have set calendar dates: Tempora Atlantia at Fall Crown (1350-1500ce) and 12th Night (Pre-history -1000CE) and Persona Pentathlon at Kingdom A&S Fair. There are also a lot of other options right now: our Kingdom MoAS (Dame Deirdre) is sponsoring a Small Group Challenge that will end in March of 2022 where artisans are supposed to work in groups of 3 to 5 to do different parts of a larger scale piece they could not complete on their own. Goodwife Michel Almond de Champagne and Mistress Muin Dunn are sponsoring a Garb Challenge at WOW where artisans are to have made an outfit for \$56 or less, wear it Saturday to the Garb Challenge at WOW (noon), and answer questions (with enthusiasm) about its construction and cost. Also, there is the Drachenwald Arts Challenge AS 56 which is due October 31st and has over 20 individual sponsored challenges (some very large scale, some not). This is just a sampling, and I'm sure depending on how far and wide that someone is willing to go, there are plenty more options.

Second, we are finally able to return to in person events. Being able to meet in person, exchange hard to acquire resources and materials, or even just encourage one another is very helpful. Talking out your stumbling blocks with others is often super helpful in taking a large project to a successful completion. Too often artisans stare at something long enough they get locked into thinking one way, getting that outside perspective of "have you tried xmaterial? Or B-technique" can send you in a new direction. Also, the ability to chat with someone else who may be working on a similar or related project can help jump start your work. In person activities allows an artisan to hand someone a finished or partially finished piece and discuss the weight/feel/texture issues that may be causing problems to continue on to the next step.

And lastly, long term projects give you time to mess up and start over. Too often with an ambitious project, especially if you have lots of new skills you're working on, you will have a number of false starts. As an artisan I often come into a project thinking it will be done in one way, and find that doesn't work well at all. Being able to make mistakes and re-start in a different way takes time, but is often invaluable to the learning and crafting process. Especially because we are often working from a find that is a partial extant example, a vague description in a period manuscript, and illumination that was drawn by someone that may know very little about the actual production process, or modern chemical analysis of very damaged extant pieces.

I know there are many fine artisans in this Barony and I hope at least some will consider joining one of the current and upcoming long term and larger scale A&S challenges.
