From the Seneschal's Pen...

Every ending had, at some time, a beginning. And every beginning will, eventually, have an ending. So, this month's column is about endings and beginnings.

Early last month I had the sad event of bidding formal farewell to our founding Baron, Master Gavin Reynes, at his funeral. That was an ending. But thanks to his foresight, the Barony now has the beginning of a new Order: The Company of Gavin (to honor those who have served Nottingham Coill as Landed Baronage.) And what was that foresight? Master Gavin had taken the step of creating a heraldic will. What, you might ask, is a heraldic will? Much like a modern will states what you want done with your belongings after your demise, a heraldic will allows you to pass along to another person or group your registered names and/or armory (personal name, household name, coat of arms and/or

badges.) You have the option of simply releasing all of it, to be adopted by anyone in the future, with no stipulation as to who that might be. You have the option of releasing your name/s and/or armory to one specific person. Or you can release each individual registered component (name/s, coat of arms, badge/s) to different people. If you do not create a heraldic will, then no one ever will be able to use that name and/or armory as long as the SCA exists. It's your choice. It's best to talk to a Herald for assistance with this, if you choose to have such a will, to be sure you have the right form and most up-to-date information. In addition to attending Master Gavin's funeral, I also attended the memorial service for Baroness Rowen the Shiftless, of Hidden Mountain. As a result of these two passings, I made the decision that I will bring with me to Pennsic a copy of their Coats of Arms. They will be affixed to the Viking Memorial Ship that is launched and set afire each year, as "a celebration of lives shared and lost." It has now been confirmed in writing to me, as Baronial Seneschal, that Their Excellencies Lucien and Brig intend to bring Their time as our baronage to an end at our Baronial Birthday next year. With that information in hand, I now have a very specific procedure and schedule to follow to ensure that our barony continues to have capable leaders for

the future. Their confirmation was the first step in the procedure. The second step requires notifying our soon-to-be new Heirs of Atlantia that the barony will have an investiture early next year. But when will that investiture take place? I don't know, at present. By this notice, also posted elsewhere in The Quill, I need to hear from anyone who is considering submitting a bid for Nottingham Coill Baronial Birthday 2019. I do not need a formal bid proposal. But I do need to know exactly which weekend you're planning for the event. Please send me an email to seneschal@nottinghamcoill.atlantia.sca.org. I must have this in hand no later than Monday April 30!

I would encourage those who are considering becoming our next Baron or Baroness to read Baroness Brig's excellent article on the subject, posted in last month's (March 2018) issue of The Quill. Very enlightening!

Part of the process (aka The Polling) for selecting new Baronage involves sending polling letters to every member (i.e. paid member) of the barony. By this column, you are notified that I intend to ask for funds sufficient to cover the costs of this polling. The formal request will take place at a Baronial Meeting at 'Eye of the Dragon' on Saturday April 21, 2018. The funds will pay for envelopes, paper, and postage.

One final item for this month: at a recent event it was realized that nowhere in our current Financial Policy is there any stipulation of which individuals are provided free event fees, feast fees, and camping/lodging fees. i.e. which people are comp'd. To correct that oversight, and with the concurrence of Their Excellencies, at the same Baronial Meeting (Eye of the Dragon) I will present an amendment to the Financial Policy. See

Proposed Addition to Baronial Financial Policy

At a recent event it was realized that nowhere in our current Financial Policy is there any stipulation of which individuals are provided complementary (free) event fees, feast fees, and camping/lodging fees. i.e. which people are comp'd. 4.2.4 Certain individuals shall be given complementary attendance at events hosted by the Barony of Nottingham Coill. 'Complementary attendance' includes payment of the event fees, feast fees, and any fees for on-site camping or on-site lodging, as posted in the event flyer. This complementary attendance applies only to the listed individuals, and does not include e.g. other family members, members of Their household, or retainers.

Boiled Eggs with Pine Nuts/Ovis Hapalis

Dominus Maximus



From Apicius, 329

Latin:

In ovis hapalis: piper, ligustcum, nucleos infusos. Suffundes mel, acetum; liquamine temperabis.

English:

For soft-boiled eggs: pepper, soaked pine nuts. Add honey and vinegar and mix with garum.

Ingredients:

- 4 small chicken or quail eggs
- 200 grams pine nuts
- 2 teaspoons ground pepper
- 1 teaspoon honey
- 4 tablespoons garum (anchovy paste can be used as a substitute)

Modern Recipe:

- First, soak the pine nuts in water overnight.
- The next morning, drain the water and grind/mortar and pestal the pine nuts finely. (some recipes do not have step)
- Mix in the honey, garum, and ground pepper.
- Heat up the sauce, careful that the sauce is not burned!
- Meanwhile, place the eggs in a pan or small pot full of cold water and bring it to a boil. If using chicken eggs, boil for about 3.5 minutes; if using quail eggs, about 1 minute.
- Take the eggs off the heat and plunge them into cold water to cool them.
- Carefully peel the eggs.
- Place the whole eggs into a deep serving bowl. (some recipes cut the egg in half.)
- Pour the pine-nut sauce over the eggs and serve.

(Call me) This article is about recruitment and retention. This article is about YOUR fun and the fun of those you have not met yet.

One of the most common complaints heard in any social organization is merely this: They never ask or let me help. It has led to the deafening sound of uncounted footsteps as people walk away.

The second reason groups appear to fail can be summed up in 3 words: I am bored. Followed quickly by a third consideration: why is it always me doing this?

The answer is the same for all three scenarios – grab someone and teach them. Be inspiring and inspired. Let them take on the thing you have been doing while you learn a new thing. They might be better at it, they might despise it (in which case you need to teach someone else) or they find they don't mind doing the thing all the time.
