Virtual Baronial Populace Meeting called!

Due to Kingdom requirements, the Financial Policy has to be updated and modified to conform to a Kingdom template.

Per the current Baronial Financial Policy:

"1.2. This document may be amended or replaced by a majority vote at a scheduled Baronial meeting"

Per the current Baronial General Policy:

- "2.2. The Baronial policies can be amended or altered by the Barony of Nottinghill Coill at any time, provided:
 - 2.2.1. All proposed changes to the Baronial policies shall be published in the Baronial newsletter
 - at least fourteen (14) days prior to the meeting in which they will be discussed and/or voted

upon.

- 2.2.2. No changes shall be made or acted upon without approval at a Baronial meeting as defined by 4.6 of this Policy.
- 2.2.3. Approved changes shall not be effective until such time as they are published in the Baronial newsletter.
- 4.6. When a vote is required, members of the Barony are defined as SCA paid members who reside or participate within the geographic boundaries of the Barony. All votes shall be decided by simple majority."

Therefore, I am calling a Baronial Populace Meeting to be held online via Zoom on Monday, January 24 at 7:00 PM. Link will be the same as used for the Baroness' Cyber Tea, and will be provided online closer to the meeting. Feel free to email me for the link.

Topic of discussion will be the acceptance of the new Financial Policy for the Barony of Nottinghill Coill. The current Financial Policy and the Proposed Financial Policy are posted in the Quill and will be available online. Anyone having difficulty obtaining a copy may email me for one.

Please read over them. If you have questions, feel free to send them to me so they can be addressed during the meeting. Questions and concerns will be taken during the meeting as well. The vote is strictly for those members of the populace who have current up-to-date memberships with the SCA. However, any member is allowed to comment or ask questions.

Anvils throughout the Ages

Now that we've discussed a general description of the blacksmith, the things they use to strike the metal, and things used to hold the metal, let us turn our attention to the most important tool of a blacksmith: the Anvil.



From before the written word, humans have been crafting from different materials, including various forms of metal. While ferrous metals had not come on the scene in large quantities, nonferrous metals had already been turned into beautiful works for centuries. Ancient legends speak of the "Anvil Stone" (first picture) that was gifted by Manannan to an Irish smith of a forgotten age. This anvil shaped stone can still be seen in Ireland today. While there is no definitive proof that this stone was used as an anvil, there are written records of stones being used as anvils before bronze and steel anvils came about.

In the second image, you see the meteorite stone found at the foot of Sierra de la Madera, and transported to Tucson, Arizona around 1850. While this particular "fallen star" anvil is post period as far as the SCA goes, there are many myths of otherworldly anvils and "anvils of the Gods" spoken about them. Meteorites account for some of the first bits of easily accessible iron ore, primarily due to the process for refining it was already started by the fall through the atmosphere.

The third is from a stone carving during the Roman times showing smiths at the forge. Here, you see that the center of a smithy were the anvil and the forge. The anvils during this period were not of the shape that we are used to in the modern era, but


were generally square or rectangular in shape. Smiths used additional tooling for specific shaping, but at some point, the anvil's flat surface (called the face) was used on every product that came out of the forge.

The fourth is a woodcut from the early Middle Ages. Here again, you can see the simple shape to the anvil, and its use hasn't changed much in the centuries since.




In the above image, you can see my personal set up, with anvil, bickern (beak iron), and hammer in a stump. This anvil, forged by me under the supervision of a more experienced smith, is around 2.5" square, with three rounded edges of various radii for shaping, and one "sharp" edge for cutting material. The bickern is used the same as the horn on a modern anvil to form scrolls and curves in steel.

In modern times, the "London Pattern" anvil is the most recognizable amongst lay persons. In the image below, the parts of the anvils are named.



Now that we've covered a (very) small bit of the history of anvils, we will continue the next article with how anvils were used and the science behind them.


