Isidora opted for a brown shaker tape strap for her basket. Guilia and Merewyn plan to weave straps for their baskets and I can't wait to see what they make.

A neighborhood friend also joined us and made a small muffin basket. All except Merewyn were 1<sup>st</sup> time weavers and everyone did great!

Baron Dressel worked on kumihimo cords which I believe he plans to donate for medallion cords. Lord Fergus worked on a tablet woven band and made lampwork beads with Lord Olaf.
